

# Warner Draw Watershed and Flood Prevention Operations Project

### Draft Plan-EA Notice of Availability



### Project Information

The United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and Washington County announce the availability of the Draft Supplemental Watershed Plan and Environmental Assessment (Plan-EA) for the Warner Draw Watershed and Flood Operations Project (Project). The Project proposes improvements at 5 locations within the Warner Draw Watershed in Washington County, Utah:

**Site 1 (Main Street Debris Basins)** – Reduce flooding to Washington City caused from stormwater runoff from the drainage area upstream of N. Main Street.

**Site 2 (Seegmiller Marsh)** – Enhance riparian habitat around Seegmiller Marsh to benefit the health of the Virgin River and fish/wildlife.

**Site 3 (Y-Drain) and Site 4 (Warner Valley Disposal System)** – Improve conveyance efficiency, reduced flooding potential, improve public safety, and extend public pathways.

**Site 5 (Hurricane Water Efficiency)** – Improve irrigation water delivery, conserve water, improve Virgin River water quantities to benefit river health and fish/wildlife habitat.

An evaluation of potential project alternatives and associated environmental impacts has been documented in the form of a Draft Plan-EA. NRCS (lead federal agency) and Washington County (Project sponsor), will hold a public meeting to provide information about the proposed Project and to collect comments on the Draft Plan-EA.

NRCS invites you to submit comments anytime during the open comment period **starting January 13, 2022 and ending on February 14, 2022.**


