



2026 UOCAVA Election Notice
For those covered by the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act
Per UCA 20A-16-502(1)

Notice Applicability:

- This notice is for *Covered Voters* including uniformed service members and their families and overseas citizens per the Act and Utah Code [20A-16-102](#).

Election Dates:

- Regular Primary Election – **June 23, 2026**
- Regular General Election – **November 3, 2026**

Ballot Information:

- Ballots are sent no later than 45 days before each election (per [UCA 20A-16-403](#)). If the 45th day falls on a weekend or holiday, ballots will be sent the business day preceding the holiday or weekend.
 - Regular Primary Election – **May 9, 2026**
 - Regular General Election – **September 19, 2026**
- To be valid, a military-overseas ballots **shall be received by 8:00 pm on election day** or submitted for mailing, electronic transmission, or other authorized means of delivery **not later than 12:01 am at the place where the voter completes the ballot, on the date of the election** (per UCA [20A-16-4-404](#))

HOW TO CAST A FEDERAL WRITE-IN ABSENTEE BALLOT (FWAB)

(Per [UCA 20A-16-502\(2\)\(b\)](#))

1. Obtain the blank FWAB (Form SF186) from [fvap.gov](#).
2. Complete the FWAB “Voter Information” page, **sign** and date.
3. On the FWAB “Official Backup Ballot”
 - a. Write the candidate name of your choice in the “Federal Offices” section as appropriate.
 - b. Write the office titles and candidate names of your choice in the “Other offices” section as appropriate as shown on [vote.utah.gov](#).
 - c. Write the ballot proposition number, constitutional amendment or other items as well as your choice “FOR” or “AGAINST” in the “Ballot initiatives or other items” section as appropriate.
4. Return the FWAB to Washington County Elections.
