2024 DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION

On March 5, 2024, Utah will be administering the 2024 Democratic Presidential Primary Election. Ballots will be mailed to registered Democratic voters, and to those who request a Democratic ballot before the February 23rd deadline.

Due to the Republican Party's decision to hold a Presidential Preference Poll in their neighborhood caucus meetings, the County will not be mailing Republican Party ballots to voters.
