This form must be submitted in accordance with the following:

(1) You must submit this request to your county clerk via mail or deliver it in person. This form cannot be sent via electronic means (such as email) or other electronic means as per Utah Code.

(2) If you are requesting the removal of your signature from an initiative petition, this form must be received no later than 5 p.m. no later than the earlier of: 30 calendar days after the day on which the voter signs the signature removal statement; 90 calendar days after the day on which the local clerk posts the voter's name; 316 calendar days after the day on which the application is filed; or for a county initiative, April 15 immediately before the next regular general election immediately after the application is filed; or for a municipal initiative, April 15 immediately before the next municipal general election immediately after the application is filed.

(3) If you are requesting the removal of your signature from a referendum petition, this form must be received no later than 5 p.m. the earlier of: 30 calendar days after the day on which the voter signs the statement requesting removal; or 45 calendar days after the day on which the local clerk posts the voter's name.
