Woundfin (Plagopterus argentissiurnus)
Dwarf Bear Poppy (Arctomecon hullis)
Siler Pincushion Cactus (Pediocactus sileri)
Virgin River Chub (Giga robusta seminuda)

An additional twenty-eight (28) species are considered candidates and may be placed on the list of threatened and endangered species with further data. A large percentage of land in Washington County is affected by these species.

In the event of "TAKE" (meaning to "harass, harm, pursue, hunt, shoot, wound, kill, trap, capture, or collect, or attempt to engage in any such conduct, Harm is further defined as an act that kills or injures such species. Such an act may include significant habitat modification or degradation where it kills or injures wildlife by significantly impairing essential breeding patterns, breeding, feeding or shelter"), fines may be levied by U, S. Fish and Wildlife Service, up to a maximum of \$50,000 and one-year imprisonment per offense.
