

**NOTICE: IMPORTANT ELECTION INFORMATION / Drop Box Locations / ADA Information
WASHINGTON COUNTY, UTAH**

To help prevent the spread of the coronavirus, for the November 3, 2020 Regular General election ONLY:

- The November 3, 2020 Regular General election will be conducted primarily by mail.
- Drop boxes will be available for depositing mail-in ballots until 8pm on Election Day (no postage required).
- There will be in-person voting at the Dixie Convention Center on Election Day.
 - Polls will be open from 7am to 8pm.
- There will be in-person Early Voting at the Dixie Convention Center.
 - Tuesday October 27 and Wednesday October 28, early voting hours are from 12:00 pm to 4:00 pm.
 - Thursday October 29 and Friday October 30, early voting hours are from 9:00am to 1:00 pm.
- Registration by provisional ballot will be available.
- The deadline for voter registration is 11 days before the election, October 23rd, 2020.
- The return postmark date is the day before the election, Monday, November 2, 2020.

How to return your ballot:

1. By mail through the US Postal Service, one first class stamp, postmarked no later than Monday, November 2, 2020, or
2. drop it off at one of our drop box locations (no postage required). All of these drop boxes are open 24 hours a day, until 8pm on Election Day, November 3, 2020, or
3. you can drop of your voted ballot in person to the Washington County Clerk's office at 197 E Tabernacle, during our normal business hours. Our offices hours are, Monday – Friday 8am to 5pm, excluding holidays.

➤ **Drop Box Locations (no postage required). No ballots can be accepted after 8pm on Tuesday, November 3, 2020:**

Individuals who are unable to vote a manual ballot (ADA) voters;

- An individual who is unable to vote a manual ballot, by mail, may contact the county clerk's office for accessible voting solutions or by reviewing the information included with each ballot mailed to the voters.
- We offer accessible voting, in-person at the Dixie Convention Center during Early Voting or on Election Day on an electronic marking device. This device can assist voters who have sight or mobility issues. Accessible voting will be available before the Election Day. Call our office at 435-986-3399 or email us at elections@washco.utah.gov if you have questions.
 - Some of the features of the electronic marking device are audio ballot, touch screen, large print and high contrast.
 - Accommodations are available to voters with disabilities who need poll worker assistance.
