WASHINGTON COUNTY, UTAH  
NOVEMBER 20, 2019  
(addition of county attorney special 2 year seat)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that candidates are to be elected for the following offices at the upcoming regular general election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

1. This is a list of offices to be filled at the regular general election to be held in Washington County, Utah on Tuesday, November 3, 2020;
2. Filing Fees for County Positions will be posted after the 2020 Budget is approved;
3. the Declaration of Candidacy filing period for qualified political party candidates and local school board candidates begins Friday, March 13, 2020 and ends at 5:00 pm, Thursday, March 19, 2020;
4. the Declaration of Candidacy filing period for local board of education candidates begins Friday, March 13, 2020 and ends at 5:00 pm, Thursday, March 19, 2020;
5. the Declaration of Candidacy filing period for justices and judges of a court of record begins Wednesday, July 1, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 15, 2020;
6. the Declaration of Intent to Gather Signatures period for qualified political party candidates begins on Thursday, January 2, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 19, 2020.
7. Qualified political party candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 14 days before the day on which the qualified political party holds its convention to select candidates for elective office.

The Washington County Clerk's office hours are Monday – Friday 8am to 5pm, excluding federal holidays, and is located at 197 E Tabernacle, St George Utah.

**1. FEDERAL**

- a. **\*U.S. President and Vice President.** These positions will be elected for a (4) year term.
- b. **\*U.S. House of Representatives.** One U.S. Congressman in the Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Congressional District for a two (2) year term. The U.S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District is located in Beaver, part of Davis, Garfield, Iron, part of Juab, Kane, Millard, Piute, part of Salt Lake, Sanpete, Sevier, Tooele, Washington and Wayne Counties.

**2. STATE**

- a. **State Executive.** The following positions will be elected for a (4) year term:

**b. Senate. (29)**

1. One member will be elected from **District Twenty-Nine (29)** for a four (4) year term. This District is located in Washington County precincts, Central and Brookside COCNBR, Dammeron Valley CODAV, Diamond Valley CODIV, Dixie Deer CODXDR, Enterprise City EN82, county area

around Enterprise City CONCF, Gunlock COGL, county area COAND, Hurricane precincts HU57 and HU61, Hurricane Valley Fire SSD precinct COHV29, Ivins precincts IV76 – IV80, county area including the Shivwits Reservation, Motoqua and 3 Mile Ln COHS74, county area outside SG20 COGUBL, Pine Valley COPINE, Santa Clara precincts SC71 – SC74, St George precincts SG01 – SG51, Winchester Hills COWH.

**Candidates must file in the county of their residence.**

### **c. UTAH STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**

1. One member will be elected from the **Utah House of Representatives District Sixty-Two (62)** for a two (2) year term. District Sixty-Two (62) is located in St George precincts SG01, SG31, SG34-SG38, SG40, SG42-SG43, SG45, SG49 and SG50. Washington precincts WA60-WA68 and WA70-WA73.

2. One member will be elected from the **Utah House of Representatives District Seventy-One (71)** for a two (2) year term. District Seventy-One (71) is located in Apple Valley AV51, county area outside Apple Valley and Zion Park COSN28, Hildale HIL97, Hurricane HU52-HU61, county area of the Hurricane Valley Fire SSD COSN28 and COSN29, LaVerkin LA85-LA87, Cliff Dweller and Sky Ranch area COCDJR, Leeds LE90, county area outside Leeds Town COLEED, New Harmony NH93, county area outside New Harmony Town CONH, Rockville RC94, Springdale SP95, St George SG44, Toquerville TQ96, Virgin VI89 and Washington WA69.

3. One member will be elected from the **Utah House of Representatives District Seventy-Four (74)** for a two (2) year term. District Seventy-Four (74) is located in Santa Clara SC71-SC74, Ivins IV76-IV80, county area including the Shivwits Reservation, Motoqua and 3 Mile Ln COHS74, St George precincts SG13-SG16, SG22-SG30, SG39, SG41, SG46 – SG48 and SG51 and county area south of SG20 COGUBL.

4. One member will be elected from the **Utah House of Representatives District Seventy-Five (75)** for a two (2) year term. District Seventy-Five (75) is located in Central and Brookside COCNBR, Dammeron Valley CODAV, Diamond Valley CODIV, Dixie Deer CODXDR, Enterprise EN82, North Central Fire SSD CONCF, County Anderson Property COAND, Gunlock COGL, Pine Valley COPINE, St George precincts SG02-SG12, SG17-SG21, SG32-SG33, Veyo COVE, Winchester Hills COWH.

**Candidates must file in the county of their residence.**

d. **STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.** One member for a (4) year term. **District Fifteen (15)** is located in Iron and Washington Counties.

**Candidates must file in the county of their residence.**

### **3. JUDICIAL**

a. **Supreme Court.** There will be a retention election for one (1) Supreme Court Judge, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.

b. **Court of Appeals.** There will be a retention election for six (6) Court of Appeals Judges, provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period.

c. **District Court.** There will be a retention election for Two (2) Judges in the Fifth Judicial District which consists of Beaver, Iron, and Washington Counties.

d. **Justice Court.** Any Justice Court judge whose term is expiring shall be subject to an unopposed retention election in the county or counties which the judge is appointed is located.

### **4. COUNTY**

a. **Commissioner “Seat C”** for a four (4) year term.

b. **County Assessor** for a four (4) year term.

\*c. **County Attorney** for a special (2) year term.

d. **County Recorder** for a four (4) year term.

### **5. LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION 1, 2, and 3**

- a. **Washington County Board of Education District #1** for a four (4) year term located in County Anderson Property COAND, Central and Brookside COCNBR, Dammeron Valley CODAV, Ivins IV76 – IV80, county area including the Shivwits Reservation, Motoqua and 3 Mile Ln COHS74, Santa Clara SC71 – SC74, Veyo COVE.
- b. **Washington County Board of Education District #2** for a four (4) year term located in Diamond Valley CODIV, St George SG02 –SG08, SG10 – SG11, SG22 – SG26 and SG48, Winchester Hills COWH.
- c. **Washington County Board of Education District #3** for a four (4) year term located in St George SG27 – SG29, SG39 – SG40, SG41 – SG46, SG49 – SG51.
